Fetal Pig Dissection Guide | Goshen College Fetal Pig Dissection and Lab Guide External Anatomy of the Fetal Pig. 1. Determine the sex of your pig by looking for the urogenital opening. On females, this opening is located near the anus. On males, the opening is located near the umbilical cord. If your pig is female, you should also note that urogenital papilla is present near the genital opening. Males do not have urogenital papilla.
