Evidence in disability discrimination claims | Legal ... When dealing with a claim of disability discrimination, you must refer to the Equality Act 2010. It states that: A person (A) discriminates against a disabled person (B) if A treats B unfavourably because of something arising in consequence of B's disability. Case Law Update: Disability Discrimination & Medical Evidence You can get legal protection if you are victimised because you've made a complaint about disability discrimination. You can also get legal protection from discrimination for helping someone else to make a complaint about disability discrimination, for example, by giving evidence as a witness in court. Here is an example of victimisation: What counts as disability discrimination - Citizens Advice Disability discrimination is when you are treated less well or put at a disadvantage for a reason that relates to your disability in one of the situations covered by the Equality Act. The treatment could be a one-off action, the application of a rule or policy or the existence of physical or communication barriers which make accessing something difficult or impossible.
