Food Service Sanitation Illinois Study Food Service Sanitation Manager Certification (FSSMC) is required by Section 750.540 of the Illinois Food Service Sanitation Code based on the food service establishment's risk category assigned by the local health department. A FSSMC is earned by completing an approved eight hour course with an Illinois approved instructor and passing a national exam accredited by the Conference for Food Protection, then paying a fee to IDPH, which is valid for five years from the exam date. These tests are designed to ensure that certification is limited to candidates who are familiar with practices, rules, regulations and training requirements specified in Illinois statutes to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public. In the the City of Chicago, the requirement is a Food Service Sanitation Manager Certificate (FSSMC) license.
