Aesculus hippocastanum: Commonly known as horse-chestnut. All parts of the plant are poisonous, causing nausea, muscle twitches, and sometimes paralysis.

Agave spp. Also known as century plant and maguey

Amaryllis: (Hippeastrum spp) All parts are toxic to cats and dogs, but especially the bulbs.

Also present in autumn. Holly: (Ilex spp) All parts of the

plant are toxic, and eating the sharp, spiky leaves can also cause damage to the throat, stomach or guts. Pets may be likely to try to eat the berries over winter.
