You must only prescribe drugs when you have adequate knowledge of your patient's health. And you must be satisfied that the drugs serve your patient's need. Prescribing and managing medicines and devices - GMC Supplementary prescribing is a voluntary partnership between an independent prescriber and a supplementary prescriber (a trained nurse, midwife, pharmacist, physiotherapist, diagnostic and therapeutic radiographer, or optometrist). The partnership implements a clinical management plan with the patient's agreement. Prescribing in general practice Prescribing variable dose and 'when required' medicines GP practices should have a written process for prescribing and issuing prescriptions to their patients who live in care homes. All medicines prescribed should be recorded in the person's GP patient medical record and their care record. Prescribing medicines for people in care homes ...
