

It won't be long till Gateshead FC take on Newcastle United Fc at the stadium on Saturday 25th July so here is some instructions ahead of the game to assist the enjoyment of your visit.

GATES OPEN 10.30am

Due to the change of phasing in the Gateshead Flyover demolition works and an event in Newcastle City Centre, we are advising customers attending the Gateshead FC v NUFC to plan ahead and leave extra time for their journey and use public transport where possible as parking will be limited at the stadium.

The Park Lane Roundabout will NOT take effect until 8.00pm

PLEASE NOTE THAT PARKING ON SITE IS FULL – Nearest parking, if available either Heworth Metro Station or the new Multi Carpark on Hawks Road NE8 3AD

Metro services will likely be busier than normal and extra staff will be on hand at Gateshead Stadium, queuing may be in place. Go North East bus services will be on diversion and may be impacted by traffic congestion on route. EAST STAND

You have selected tickets within the **EAST STAND** that is accessed via the lower field which is also our pre-booked carpark.

The access to this area is via gates from ½ way down Neilson Road that will direct you around the north of the ground to the ticket check point at the southeast corner of the Lower Field Car Park.

Please have your QR code ready for scanning.

Once cleared the bag check and ticket scan point, proceed up the staircase to the rear of the east stand which will also lead onto the Bar area which has been set up to provide a drinking area that we can provide which does not look onto the pitch, in order to comply with FA regulations and Alcohol at Football Grounds. In this area will be a food van and an ice cream van as well as 2 food outlets inside the stand itself.

All Bar and Food outlets in East Stand are CARD ONLY

Please note what seat number you have selected and ask Stewards or look at signage to assist with where about in the stand your seat can be found.

To help, seating starts at no.1 at the North end and increases as you move along (away from the River Tyne End)

Seats start at Rows 'Z' at the top going down to Row 'A' at pitch-side.

Please note that Rows A & B are not in use.

Please assist us on the day by placing any rubbish in the wheely bins at the top of the stands.

At the end of the game, the exit is the same way as you came in, and the Cr Park will be held back for 15-20 minutes at the end to help the dispersal of pedestrians.
